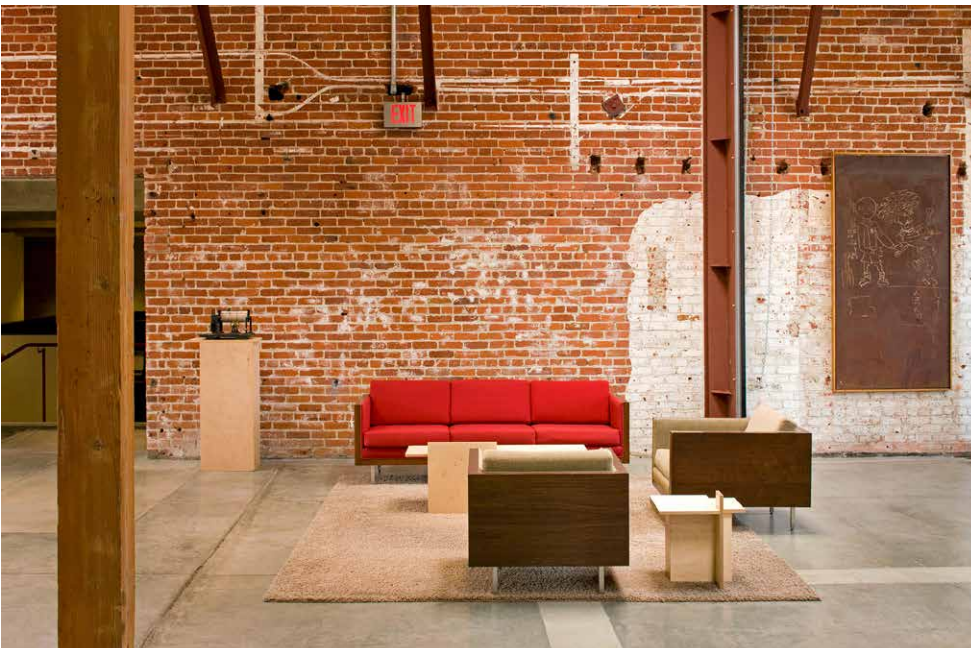




Biscuit Filmworks

Considering the original two warehouse structures to be “found objects”, we proceeded to gut them and graft them together to create a new structure. Using ribbed glass and board-formed concrete, we created a nuanced relationship between the new construction and existing buildings, consciously blurring the distinction between the comfort of home and the intensity of the work environment. A contrast between textured materials such as reclaimed wood and encaustic cement tile, with more industrial materials, honors the company’s vision for their workplace as a “factory for making”.
